Tile selection	
Unglazed (i.e. stoneware) or natural stone	
Aesthetics not affected by treatments	
No warpage in tiles	
Tile to grout ratio less than 1:6	
Coating selection	
Chemical coating or abrasive coating with hard, angular particles	
Particle size fit with nature of use	
Abrasive particles evenly distributed in coating	
Maintenance- Inform consumer about	
Cleaning products and processes suitable for tile	
Cleaning products and processes suitable for coating	
Cleaning products and processes suitable for contaminants	
Cleaning products and processes suitable for hygiene	
Cleaning requirements	
Coating reapplication as needed	
Budget considerations - in comparing costs, consider	
Effectiveness of coating	
Frequency of reapplication	
Special cleaning products or processes
