b. HMinfo Website Progress

Development during this period was focused on upgrading the HMinfo website so that it is compatible with the ANDS (Australian National Data Service) DOI (Digital Object Identifier) machine-to-machine minting service plugin developed during the last reporting period.

The test version of the upgrades is complete and deployed live.

The website is currently linked to the test version of the ANDS system in order to review the new website functionality:

- Finer control of contributor information
- Links to researcher identifiers such as ORCID
- Ability to relate publications to superseded publications
- Automatic synchronisation between publication data and DOI citation data
- Protection of publications that are required to be persistent due to DOI relationship
- Administrative list of frequently used contributors

Upcoming tasks:

- Adjust DOI integration based on test outcomes and switch to live mode when ready
- Website responsive design (to ensure that the website is mobile friendly on various devices)
